Student Placement Guide

TISOL uses a policy of age-based placement so that children are in classes of socially similar students. Teachers then place students in groups within their classes according to specific ability so that students are appropriately challenged. Please refer to the following guide to see which class your child should be enrolled into:

If on April 1st your child is:

18 months old, they will join	Young Toddlers (ECC)
3 years old.....	Older Toddlers (ECC)
4 years old.....	Preschool
5 years old.....	Prep
6 years old.....	Grade 1
7 years old.....	Grade 2
8 years old.....	Grade 3
9 years old.....	Grade 4
10 years old.....	Grade 5
11 years old.....	Grade 6

Within the International Education Agency, Prep represents the first year of formal education. In some foreign countries (eg. Queensland, Australia), Grade 1 is the first year of formal schooling in which case, a student who transfers from Grade 1 in Queensland would be placed in our Prep program and so forth, depending on how many years of formal education they have had.
